





## Use and Care Spray Stand

Use CanSlip SE to: Help prevent asphalt sticking to truck boxes.

Using CanSlip SE:

- Mix 1 part CanSlip SE to 10 parts of water.
- ♦ Best working temperature range is 5°C to 50°C

Stand Setup	Spraying Truck Boxes
<ul> <li>Venturi injectors and other equipment used to dilute the product should only be adjusted by plant manager or authorized persons.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Special attention should be given to the corners of the truck bed.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Do not allow rainwater to leak into the drum of CanSlip SE concentrate.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Release agent is normally applied at the beginning of the shift and is effective for up to three loads before re-spraying is required.</li> </ul>

To Ensure Effectiveness	Cautionary Measures
<ul> <li>Spray mixture sparingly – one litre per truck bed.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Exercise care when spraying in windy conditions. Fine mist is an inhalation hazard.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Over-spraying lowers the effectiveness.</li> <li>Emulsion leaves protective oily film when the</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Product can make spray stands and hoses slippery if not removed from surfaces.</li> </ul>
water evaporates.	<ul> <li>Product soaked cloths are a potential fire hazard and should be stored in approved containers.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>MultiSolv "HotHut" enclosures can be used to keep product at working temperature in cooler weather conditions.</li> </ul>	1
